SATURDAY 11 JUNE 2016 – LOXTON TO MOOROOK

Sections of the River Murray commencing at Loxton foreshore 489 km mark, and continuing downstream to Moorook in sequence as follows:

489 km to 482 km	10.30 am to 12.30 pm
482 km to 475 km	11.30 am to 1.00 pm
475 km to 468 km	12.30 pm to 2.00 pm
468 km to 461 km	1.30 pm to 3.00 pm

Also an area of water at Moorook foreshore, commencing at the boat ramp and extending downstream for 200 metres and also extending for 20 metres out from shore, between the hours of 1.30 pm and 5.00 pm.

An access corridor must be provided on the starboard side of the river for the passage of normal river traffic, at a speed of 4 knots. ٠

SUNDAY 12 JUNE 2016 - DEVLINS POUND TO WAIKERIE

Sections of the River Murray commencing at the 409 km mark near Devlins Pound and continuing downstream to Waikerie in sequence as follows:
